Section 14 Summary

To ensure compliance with the EA Study during construction, operation and closure, the Regions will prepare and submit an Environmental Assessment Compliance Monitoring Program to the MOE for consideration. The program will include monitoring of the fulfillment of the EA Study document's mitigation measures, consultation, further studies and work to be carried out, as well as commitments made and described in the EA Study.

14. Monitoring Program

Subsequent to EA Study approval, the Regions will prepare and submit an Environmental Assessment Compliance Monitoring Program to the MOE for consideration. The purpose of Program will be to ensure compliance with the EA Study. The Program will include monitoring of the fulfillment of the EA Study's mitigation measures, consultation, further studies and work to be carried out, as well as commitments made and described in the EA Study (Section 11; summarized in Section 13), including those that result from the review of the EA Study by the government and the public.

The program will address all phases of the Proposed Undertaking, as required, including planning, detailed design, construction, operation, closure, and decommissioning. The program will include compliance monitoring, and where appropriate, effects monitoring. The program will also contain an implementation schedule to be followed for completion of the commitments. The program will be submitted on the earlier of one year following the end of the month after approval of the EA Study or 60 days before the commencement of construction.

If the Project were to be approved and proceed, the Regions will, as part of the EPA (CofA) reporting process, also report on compliance with the conditions of approval set out in the "Notice of Approval" and the results of the EA Compliance Monitoring Program. When all EA conditions have been satisfied, the Regions will indicate this in the Compliance Report, and confirm at that time that the latest Compliance Report will be its final submission in regards to EA compliance. Afterwards, the Regions will continue to report on EPA compliance as required.

In addition, the Regions will maintain these reports onsite and will make the reports available in a timely manner to the MOE upon request.
