1	October 28, 2025	DYEC Project Email	<p>Good morning:</p> <p>As one who has been involved with the incinerator since 2006 and remain actively involved, I've been checking the DYEC website periodically over the last 3 months to see if the ECA applications for capacity increase to 160,000 were posted.</p> <p>Because of many ongoing shortcomings of Durham's DYEC website notifications process that I've brought to Durham staff's attention many times, I can never be sure if and when I would get a notification so continue to check periodically when expecting documents. (I resubscribed to that 160K) page again this morning - an experiment to see what happens going forward because I had to resubscribe multiple times to other DYEC web pages before I started to get some notifications)</p> <p>QUESTIONS TO WHICH I'D APPRECIATE YOUR TIMELY RESPONSE</p> <p>WHEN was the ECA Application package posted to the DYEC's 160,000 capacity page?</p> <p>WHAT steps did Durham staff take to advise possible interested parties beyond those who commented during the EA Screening process? Though I commented during the EA Screening PICs and submitted details comments to MECP re the EA Screening report, I was not notified as a result of that demonstrated interest in the capacity increase. Recall that when Durham updated the DYEC website, staff admitted that they did not "port" the interested parties mailing list that had been developed since 2011.</p> <p>WHO was notified about the posting of the ECA application package? Note, I'm subscribed to multiple pages on the DYEC website including the one for 160,000 increase, and did not receive a notification.</p> <p>I'm a member since inception in 2011 of the Energy from Waste Advisory Committee required by Condition 8 of the 2010 EA Approval. I did not receive an email advising members of the ECA application posting though it's obvious EFWAC members should have been advised.</p> <p>WAS an email about the ECA Application package sent to EFWAC members and if yes, when? If not, when do you plan to advise EFWAC members of</p>	<p>Hello,</p> <p>I hope all is well and thank you for your email.</p> <p>As mentioned previously, the ECA process falls under the responsibility of the MECP for any required posting or circulation for comments associated with the Project. This is in contrast to the EA or screening process which is proponent led for consultation. The Regions have previously agreed to post the background materials to the website for information and this was completed on October 8, 2025.</p> <p>Per the ECA process, the Region is currently awaiting confirmation from the MECP that the application materials have been received, as well as for any next steps required by the Ministry.
